# Revise Class Size

- Refill classes need up from 2008-09 to 2009-10
- Five classes and 110student (Duvleneck, Barron Park (2), Briones, and Nixon)



# Revise Class Size

- Every increase of one student results in 250 additional seats
- At present, class sizes are 21 at Kindergarten and grades 2 and 3; 22 at first grade; and 23 at grades 4-5, on average



# Increase Capacity at Ohlone

- Over the next three years, capacity will increase by about 66 students



# Begin Plans for Full Fourth Strand at Fairmeadow

- Adds four classrooms and about 90 students
- Identified by Gelfand as school with ability to add capacity



# Place Students at Greendell

- Jewish Community Center is leaving this fall, freeing up three to six classrooms (up to 132 students)
- These classes should be kindergarten classrooms
