- ❖ **What is the LCAP? The DELAC group and DAC grouped met together to review the LCAP. Director, Judy Argumedo explained that the DELAC is a group for parents of English Language Learners and the DAC is a parent advisory committee on the LCAP. Both groups will provide feedback to the district. The director went through a powerpoint presentation on what the LCAP is, and how progress is measured through the California Dashboard. She explained that current data on PAUSD will be released publicly in mid-December. Questions about the pie charts and colors were explained.**
- ❖ **Overview of 2018-2019 LCAP The director reviewed the four goals of the PAUSD LCAP. Many members had specific questions and feedback, which she directed them to write on the feedback form to be captured. One question on the first goal was around training teachers. The director explained that the professional learning in PAUSD is well rounded and parents expressed an interest in having access to the current offerings.**
