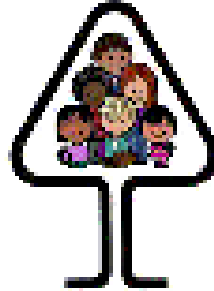

Our students with a hearing loss are integrated into the general education school learning environment, taught the same curriculum as their hearing peers by general education teachers, and receive special education services from an Itinerant teacher and an Educational Audiologist.

Our program provides direct and/or consultative special education services relating to hearing loss. Our students range in age from 3 through 21 and may have a hearing loss and/or additional disabilities.
