Exemptions: Free/Reduced-fee transportation are available at Student Services. Families who receive a District letter confirming the approval of a free/reduced meal may attach the approval letter to their bus pass application at the time the apply for transportation.

Please Note the Following:

Pupil must maintain order at all times & obey the instruction of the bus driver.

Only those students who have a School Bus Pass will be allowed to ride the bus.

First student in household pays full price, additional students in same household pay "sibling discount" price.

Single Ride Bus Pass for PM only available to purchase for \$5 for single use. Available to purchase at the Transportation office.

Bus passes will be issued on a first come first serve basis.

Rules and Responsibilities for the School Bus

Responsibilities of the Driver:

By law, the driver is responsible for the safety of all passengers aboard a school bus. The driver has absolute authority over all passengers. Student safety is our most important consideration. The standards of behavior on the school bus are the same as those for any school in the District.

Responsibilities of the Passenger:

Students will be expected to follow standards of appropriate classroom conduct while on board the school bus and will be held accountable for their behavior. They will:

- Respect the authority of the driver
- Board and exit the bus in an orderly manner
- Students are required to wear seatbelts and be seated at all times
- Keep their hands to themselves
- Face forward and stay in their seat, and keep their head, and feet inside the bus at all times
- Talk quietly and with respect
- Not eating on the bus
- Cellphone use: The driver has the full discretion to limit use of all devices in any situation where use cell phone could be potentially dangerous or disruptive, or the student has exhibited disruptive behavior.

The driver is responsible for the safety of all passengers aboard a school bus and has the authority to enforce all the rules. The bus driver is authorized to assign seats. Infractions of the rules will be reported to the school principal and disciplinary action will be taken.

School bus transportation is a privilege within California, passengers who choose to exhibit negative behavior and/or contribute to an unsafe ride for others, may have these privileges revoked

Responsabilidades del Chofer:

- Hablaran en voz baja y con respeto
- Uso de telefono celular, El chofer tiene la autoridad al limitar el use de aparatos dijetales en cualquier situacion. Donde pueda ser un peligro, distraccion o si el estudiante tiene mal compartamiento.

El chofer es responsable por la seguridad de todos los pasajeros abordo del autobus escolar y tiene la autoridad para hacer cumplir todas las reglas. El chofer esta autorizado para asignar asientos. Las infracciones de las reglas se reportaran al director/a de las escuela y se llevara a cabo una accion disciplinarian.

El transporte escolar es un privilegio en California. Los pasajeros que deciden comportarse negativamente y/o contribuyen a un viaje inseguro para otros, pueden perder estos privilegios.
